New savings on Rx you take regularly

Effective January 1, 2022 your prescription benefit plan will include the Preventive Drug List. It gives you an easy way to save on medications you take every day

Attached is more information on the prescription changes that will go into effect January 1, 2022. The plan enhancement covers “preventative” prescriptions at NO cost to the member for many conditions, including:

- Cholesterol
- High Blood Pressure
- Diabetes
- Mental Health/Depression
- Heart Disease

The expanded \$0 cost list may significantly reduce the prescription cost during the plan year.

How do I save money?

You'll pay \$0 for medications on the Preventive Drug List – even if you haven't met your plan deductible yet.

Is it complicated?

Not at all. The Preventive Drug List will be part of your plan starting January 1, 2022. Your pharmacy will then automatically charge you \$0. If a medication you take regularly is not on the list, just ask your doctor if a listed medication might be right for you.
