Finding ways to keep your medication costs affordable is our top priority. That's why your prescription benefit plan now includes the Preventive Drug List. It gives you an easy way to save on medications you take every day (such as high blood pressure or asthma medication).

How do I save money?

You'll pay \$0 for medications on the Preventive Drug List – even if you haven't met your plan deductible yet.

Is it complicated?

Not at all. The Preventive Drug List will be part of your plan starting January 1, 2022. Your pharmacy will then automatically charge you \$0. If a medication you take regularly is not on the list, just ask your doctor if a listed medication might be right for you.

Want to see if your Rx is on the list?

Starting **January 1, 2022**, you can view The Preventive Drug List at **www.epcschools.org**. After this date, you can also use the Check Drug Cost tool at **www.caremark.com** to see medication costs.
